He is a recent graduate of The Crane School of Music with a Music Composition and Music Education. Born and raised in Port Jefferson, music was always a part of

Together with his father and sister Andie Juliette, they perform as a family trio called Tricycle. He has released an EP of original music entitled Cafe Nostalgia as well as three new singles that were released in 2023.
